



9. Program Rules/ Student-Parent Agreement

Pan Atlantic High School Abroad Program Rules

1. Respect the host family and uphold their family rules regarding curfews, household chores, internet and cell phone usage, smoking and dating.
2. Pan Atlantic requires all students to read and understand both the Pan Atlantic Handbook and any handbook from the receiving provider in country.
3. No Drinking of alcoholic beverages including beer or wine. This includes sale, purchasing or possession.
4. No usage of drugs or association with drugs in any way. This includes sale, purchasing, possession, or being in the presence of others using drugs of any kind.
5. No use of firearms.
6. No driving of cars or other motor driven vehicles is allowed at any time.
7. Pan Atlantic Foundation/its agents and representatives will place each student in home that is determined to be appropriate for student well-being, health and safety. Each student must take responsibility for their personal health and safety needs when agreeing to be placed by Pan Atlantic Foundation. Students with any health condition that would create a risk of injury, sickness or any other risk on program should not participate in an exchange program. Any pre-existing personal health condition of this nature that is not disclosed in the application process but is discovered while on program will be subject to dismissal at the discretion of Pan Atlantic Foundation. Students with any life threatening medical conditions, mental illness, eating disorder or self-endangering activity may be dismissed from the program at the discretion of Pan Atlantic.
8. Pan Atlantic Foundation students must maintain a C+ overall semester/trimester average or greater in all academic courses at the host high school, as well as a C+ average or greater in each individual course, academic or otherwise.
9. It is forbidden to access websites in the host country with pornographic and extreme violent content or to watch films with this content.
10. It is not permitted to upload any pictures, names or private information about your host family on public internet sites i.e. Instagram, Facebook, blogs without permission.
11. Travel is permitted only with adult members of the host family, the Area Representative, or official school or group organized trips. Students must obtain written permission from Pan Atlantic Foundation prior to booking any flights and/or if any travel results in a school absence exceeding



one day. Pan Atlantic must approve any visits from the natural family prior to travel arrangements made/flights purchased. Natural family visits are not permitted until the end of the program. Travel to your home country in the event of emergency must be approved by Pan Atlantic. Visits from friends overseas during program year are not permitted.

12. Hitchhiking or soliciting a ride from a stranger is prohibited.
13. Students must have access to \$200 per month to cover personal expenses. Money should never be exchanged between the student and host family for the purposes of borrowing or lending money. Any student being asked by any host family member to borrow money, or any host family member being asked by the student to borrow money, should report this incident to Pan Atlantic Foundation immediately.
14. Students should not smoke. This includes the use of electronic cigarettes.
15. Participation in extracurricular activities or athletics is never guaranteed. Placements may not be rejected or changed based on access to a particular sport or activity.
16. Employment is not allowed on either a full or part-time basis while on your program.
17. Students arriving on program pregnant or becoming pregnant on program will be dismissed from the program.
18. Life decisions including but not limited to marriage, changing religion, renunciation of citizenship, or physical alterations such as tattoos, body piercings or cosmetic surgery, are not permitted on program.
19. Students must demonstrate maturity and good character in their application as well as on program. Students shall refrain from any form of sexual harassment, bullying, cyber-bullying, or hate crimes.
20. Photos, comments, and content posted on social media that depicts or describes a violation of program rules may result in student dismissal.
21. Students determined to be in need of academic tutoring will be required to pay for the associated fees.
22. Students are required to maintain contact with their Area Representative on a monthly basis and are responsible for returning Area Representative (or any other Pan Atlantic Foundation representatives) phone calls or emails within 48 hours.
23. Pan Atlantic is not acting in the capacity of in loco parentis with respect to the students. Natural parents or guardians still retain all rights and obligations.
24. All students must return to their home country after completing their program.



25. Failure to abide by the above listed rules may result in program dismissal. When a student is dismissed for failure to abide by Pan Atlantic Foundation Program Rules, the natural parent or guardians are responsible for any additional expenses incurred, including adjusted airfare, transportation, accommodations associated with the early return. In the case of early dismissal, program fees will not be reimbursed.
